

McLane Creek Woods Trail - Washington State Capitol Forest, Olympia, WA

This was a 1.1 mile out and back gravel/boardwalk trail – this is supposed to be a loop trail but steps to bridges on the east side stop you from crossing the final bridges, we had to retrace our path. Start loop going clockwise (west)

This wooded trail around a beaver pond takes you to beautiful views of the creek and there are many great boardwalks.

Salmon run during spawning season and can be viewed from observation points along the creek.

We took our trail chair because of the stumps on the trail and some lips on the bridges would be difficult with a manual chair.

Adventurous manual chair users may want to try this trail in drier seasons. Future improvements to the trail will be done.

Pit toilet bathroom on site, trail chair friendly.
